SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES CAPTURE SUSPECT WANTED IN CONNECTION WITH A ROBBERY SPREE AFTER HIGH SPEED PURSUIT

Town of Onondaga: Onondaga County Sheriff Kevin E. Walsh this afternoon reported that a robbery suspect was taken into custody after a high speed pursuit that was initiated in the Town of Camillus and ended in the Town of Marcellus.

A robbery suspect was taken in to custody this morning by Sheriff's Deputies after a brief pursuit that was initiated on W. Genesee Street near Munro Road in the Town of Camillus. Dep. J. Ingram had spotted the suspect's vehicle, a 1988 Mercedes, being driven by Daryl D. Williams, age 39, of 9 John Street, Auburn NY, on W. Genesee Street approaching Monroe Road. When Dep. Ingram attempted to stop Williams, Williams accelerated his Mercedes in an attempt to flee from police. Dep. Ingram continued his pursuit of Williams and was assisted by members of the Camillus Police Department and members of the State Police. As Williams was traveling on Dunbar Woods Road, he lost control of his vehicle and collided in to the wooded area adjacent 2746 Dunbar Woods Road. After Williams' car became disabled Williams fled into the woods on foot, Dep. Ingram was able to over take him and place him in custody. He was assisted by other officers on the scene.

Dep. H. Ryan gave the following account of William's robbery spree. At approximately 6:27 am this morning, Williams entered the Elbridge Mini Mart, 101 E. Main Street, Elbridge, and asked the clerk for change. When the clerk opened the register Williams reached over the counter and grabbed the money out of the cash register and then fled the store. Then at 8:27 am, Williams entered the Clark Mart Mobile, 1387 E. Genesee Street, Skaneateles NY and made a purchase. When the clerk opened the cash register Williams again reached over the counter and grabbed the money in the cash drawer. The New York State Police are currently investigating the two aforementioned incidents.

Ryan stated that at 10:05 am Williams entered the Quickway, 4464 W. Seneca Turnpike, Town of Onondaga, and asked the clerk for change. When the clerk opened the cash drawer Williams reached over the counter and attempted to grab the money. The store clerk attempted to stop Williams by grabbing his arm but he was able to free his arm. He then fled and was chased by store employees. While being chased Williams made a motion that made the employees think he had a weapon. Employees stopped chasing Williams but were able to get the license plate number off the vehicle he fled in.

Sheriff's Deputies will be charging Williams with Robbery in the 3rd Degree and numerous traffic violations. Williams will be lodged in the Justice Center pending his next court date. State Police will continue with their investigation regarding the Elbridge Mini Mart and the Clark Mobile.

While taking Williams in to custody, Dep. Ingram injured his left ankle. He was transported to Community General Hospital for treatment and released.
