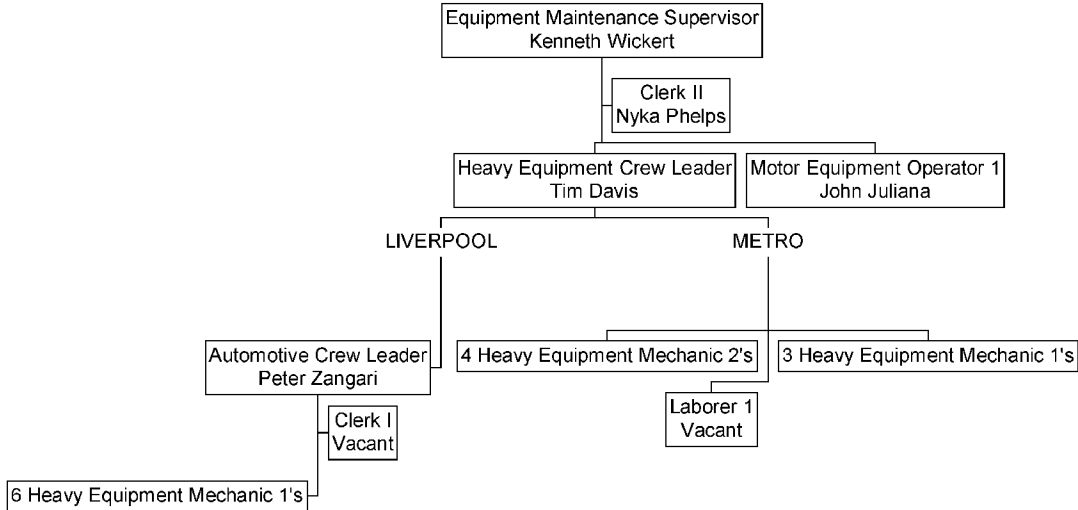

Chapter 7

Fleet Management

7.1 Introduction

The Fleet Management Division consists of three repair facilities. Two of the repair facilities are located at the Metro Administrative Building. The staffing at the Metro location consists of one Equipment Maintenance Supervisor, one Heavy Equipment Crew Leader, one Clerk II, four Heavy Equipment Mechanics II, three Heavy Equipment Mechanics I, one Motor Equipment Operator and one General Laborer. The Metro Garage repairs, cargo vans, small, medium and large duty trucks and heavy equipment.

One satellite repair facility is located at the Onondaga Lake Park. The staffing at the Onondaga Lake Park location currently consists of one Automotive Crew Leader and six Heavy Equipment Mechanics I and one Clerk I. The Onondaga Lake Park Garage repairs all passenger cars, SUV's, minivans, mowers and various other types of small equipment.

Fleet Management provides maintenance, repair, distribution and disposal of vehicles to several County departments. The departments provided daily service are the Consolidated Sewer District, Flood Control, District Attorney, Facilities Management, Sheriff, Corrections, Fire Coordinator, Health, Social Services, Van Duyn, 911 Center, Hillbrook, Onondaga County Public Library, Motor Pool and Parks Department motor vehicles and equipment. Fleet Management is in charge of more than 800 vehicles, trailers and various types of construction and specialized maintenance equipment. Fleet Management also maintains and repairs more than 30 stationary power generators located throughout the district.
