

Winter Assistance Benefits Tip Sheet for AAAs

The following tip sheet is designed to help Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) in their outreach and assistance efforts this winter. Please use this guide to help clients who may be eligible for benefits necessary to be safe this winter at home. In most instances, eligibility is based on income and other requirements. See links for further information about eligibility.

HEAP Regular Arrears Supplement	Assistance for eligible households unable to pay unpaid electric and/or gas utility.	9/22/21 to 9/30/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#regular-arrears- supplement-benefit
HEAP Regular Benefit	Helps eligible households meet the cost of heating their homes, including fuel, a utility source, heating equipment replacement, and repairs.	10/1/21 to 3/15/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#regular-benefit
HEAP Clean and Tune Benefit	Helps eligible homeowners with the cost of cleaning primary heating equipment, such as: chimney cleaning, minor repairs, installation of carbon monoxide detectors or programmable thermostats, if needed, to allow for the safe, proper, and efficient operation of the heating equipment.	10/1/21 to 9/30/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#tune-benefit
HEAP Heating Equipment Repair/Replacement	Helps eligible households with the cost to repair (up to \$3,000) or replace (up to \$6,500) the applicant's primary heating equipment.	10/1/21 to 9/30/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#repair-benefit
HEAP Emergency*	Assistance for households in danger of running out of fuel or having utility service shut off.	1/3/22 to 3/15/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#emergency-benefit
HEAP Cooling	Assistance in the purchase and installation (not to exceed \$800) of an air conditioner or a fan.	5/2/22 to 8/31/22	https://otda.ny.gov/programs/heap/#cooling-assistance

EmPower NY	 Available to homeowners or renters. Participating contractors provide a home energy assessment. Homeowners or renters may be eligible for free improvements such as: no-cost directinstall measures (i.e., energy efficient lighting); insulation and air sealing; replacement of old/inefficient refrigerators and freezers; heating and hot water repair/replacements. Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program	 Discount covering up to 50% of the cost of eligible energy efficiency improvements up to \$5,000 per project for single-family homes. Two- to four-unit residential homes with income-eligible residents may qualify for a discount of up to \$10,000. The program is available for both renters and owners. NYS Weatherization Assistance Program	Helps reduce heating and cooling costs for income- eligible homeowners by providing free improvements: sealing of cracks and holes; insulation of attics and walls; heating system repairs or replacement; providing efficient lighting and refrigeration; window and/or outside door repair or replacement; mitigation of energy-related health and safety issues. A household is automatically eligible if a member receives HEAP benefits or certain other forms of public assistance.

Energy Affordability Program (EAP)	Provides income-eligible customers with a monthly bill credit on gas/electric utilities.	N/A	Customers are automatically enrolled when participating in HEAP and other qualifying programs. Contact your utility for questions or issues accessing the EAP benefit.
Home Energy Fair Practices Act (HEFPA) Residential Consumer Rights	Provides customers with comprehensive protections in areas relating to their energy service such as: the application, termination and reconnection of service; customer billing; and complaint procedures. HEFPA also includes special protections and shut-off procedures for circumstances where customer health and safety may be threatened by lack of service. Specifically, between November 1 and April 15, providers must make a special effort to determine whether terminating heat-related service will result in serious impairment to health or safety. Low Income Household Water Assistance Program	Helps people pay past-due drinking water or wastewater bills. Benefits are paid directly to vendors. If bills are past due, applicants may be eligible for up to \$2,500 (drinking-water bills); \$2,500 (wastewater bills); \$5,000 (combined drinking-water/wastewater bills).
