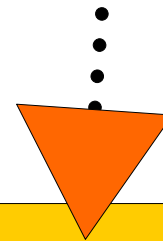

### NY Fresh Checks Are Here!

If food stamp customers purchase a minimum of \$5 at the mobile market with their Food Stamps EBT Card, they will **receive an additional \$5** in the form of a NY Fresh Check.

It can be used the same as cash to purchase any food stamp eligible foods from the mobile market. It can be used that day or for future purposes from the mobile market.

**You can only receive one per day**, but you can come back every mobile market day to receive additional NY Fresh checks.
