



HISTORY:

In 1988 the Onondaga County Legislature passed Local Law No. 9. The law established the rules, regulations, and fees for plumbing installations in Onondaga County. The law was amended in 2004 with Local Law No. 6. This amended law provided for the transfer of the plumbing inspections from the Onondaga County Department of Health to the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection effective March 20, 2004.

The Plumbing Control Laws are overseen by the Examining Board for Plumbers. This 10 member board was created by the Board of Supervisors per Resolution No. 167 dated April 3, 1967.

Periodically, the Onondaga County Legislature passes a new law with the updated fees for plumbing exams, plumbing fees and plan review fees. The last Local Law passed for an update of fees was October 8, 2013. The new fees are effective January 1, 2014.

SINGLE FIXTURE ISSUE:

In 2013 there were 344 permits issued for single fixture replacements at a cost of \$50 each. Of these 344 permits issued, 235 were inspected. Per our discussion with the Plumbing Control Supervisor of Onondaga County, the plumbing inspectors stop at all permit locations during the year but are not always able to perform inspections. In these instances, the inspector will leave their card with their number for the owner to contact and set up another date for inspection. Per WEP, generally 40 to 50% of the people will call the inspector back. If the owner does call back, they are not charged an additional fee for the additional stop. The reasons provided as to why an inspection may not be completed are as follows; inspectors may not be allowed in the house, the job is not finished or able to be inspected at the appointment date, the work may not be up to code, no one in the home is over the age of 18 at the time of the stop and type of work being inspected requires more than 1 visit.

2013 PERMIT & INSPECTION ACTIVITY:

Per WEP, each year approximately 4,100 plumbing permits are issued and approximately 450 plan review fees are charged. This summary was obtained from the Plumbing Control Supervisor for Onondaga County who reports to the Sewer Maintenance Engineer of Onondaga County. Each year the number of inspection stops for permits is approximately 6,200. A stop is when a County inspector visits the permitted site for inspection. The reasons for the difference in the permit inspection stops versus the actual plumbing permits issued are outlined in the previous paragraph.

The Plumbing Control department keeps a monthly log of the stops made by the County plumbing inspectors each day of each month. The total of these sheets agree to the Monthly Plumbing Control Sheet. The Monthly Plumbing Control Sheet references the total inspection stops made each month and for what purpose. It also tallies the total inspection stops by each inspector each month.

Regulation of Plumbing

*Local Law No. 9, 1988, as amended by Local Law No. 6, 2004
(Local Law No. 6, 2004 provides for transfer of the plumbing function from the Onondaga County Department of Health to the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection effective March 20, 2004)*

Onondaga County, New York
A local law of the County of Onondaga
Establishing rules, regulations, and fees for plumbing installations

BE IT ENACTED by the Onondaga County Legislature, Onondaga County, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. Definition of Terms

Whenever used in any Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection Local Law, the following respective terms, unless otherwise therein expressly defined, shall mean and include each of the meanings herein respectively set forth.

(a) Mechanical Trade Section: That section of the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection that enforces the plumbing code of the County of Onondaga as well as any publication amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.

(b) Local Law or Ordinance: Any local law or ordinance duly adopted and posted as an Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection Local Law or Ordinance.

(c) Owner: Any person, firm, association, co-partnership or other entity have title to land, with or without buildings, within the County of Onondaga.

(d) Examining Board for Plumbers: A ten member board created by the Board of Supervisors as per Resolution No 167 dated April 3, 1967.

(e) Plumbing Inspector: Any person duly appointed by the Onondaga County Commissioner of Water Environment Protection or his agents as a Plumbing Inspector.

(f) Permits: A Plumbing Permit to do any act shall authorize the same only insofar as it may be performed in strict accordance with the terms of the conditions thereof.

(g) Person: Any natural person, corporation, company, association, joint stock association, firm, co-partnership or other entity.

(h) Code: The Onondaga County Plumbing Code shall consist of the general provisions and definitions pertaining to the plumbing requirements (including facilities for the physically handicapped) that are contained within the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code in addition to any and all requirements for the implementation of said Code as set forth by the Onondaga County Examining Board for Plumbers.

(i) Certificate Holder: Any person who has qualified himself with the Onondaga County Examining Board for Plumbers as competent to engage in the business of plumbing in Onondaga County and has met all current requirements of the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection.

(j) Journeyman Plumber: Any person who has met the requirements of the Onondaga County Examining Board for Plumbers and has further met all current requirements of the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection.

Section 2. Regulations

(a) Permits:

1. Only those persons who are certified as competent by the Onondaga County Examining Board for Plumbers as Master Plumbers, Plumbing Contractors Class B or Plumbing Contractors Class C and are duly licensed as such by the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection may obtain Permits for installing plumbing in the County of Onondaga except as otherwise provided in this section. Any person who obtains a Permit for any other individual, partnership or corporation violates this local law. A Permit must be obtained from the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection before starting any work under this authority.
2. Homeowners may be issued a Permit in compliance with subdivision 4- article (b) of Section 2.

(b) Installations:

All work under this authority may be done only pursuant to a duly issued permit by the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection and must be performed by:

1. Properly licensed Master Plumbers or Class B or C plumbing contractors.
2. Properly licensed journeyman plumbers.
3. Properly registered apprentice plumbers.
4. Any person who desires to remodel add-to or in any way alter the plumbing system in his or her own home under the following conditions:
 - a. The title to said premises must be either in the name of the person to do the work or jointly in the name of his or her spouse.
 - b. Said home must be no larger than one family size.
 - c. Said person must submit a letter of intent and request to the Plumbing Control Section for permission and approval.
 - d. All work done by said person must be inspected by an Onondaga County Plumbing Inspector and must conform to local code.
 - e. It shall be prohibited for any such person to connect a private sewer to any public sewer within the County of Onondaga.

Section 3. Fees

Section 4. Violations

The following are hereby deemed to be violations of this local law:

- (a) Any person who installs plumbing work within the County without first obtaining a permit as set forth in 2.
- (b) Any person who installs plumbing work within the County of Onondaga without inspection, approval and conformity to the code. Each violation of the code shall constitute a separate violation of this Local Law.
- (c) Any person who installs plumbing work within Onondaga County and does not comply with paragraph (b) of this law.
- (d) Any person who allows harmful deposits (as defined by the Code) to enter any of the Onondaga County Sanitary District Sewers.

Section 5. Penalties Civil and Criminal

Any person, firm, association, co-partnership, corporation or other entity violating any of the provisions of this Local Law, or any rule or regulation therein contained, shall be guilty of an offense and shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty or fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for not more than one hundred (100) days or both; Such fine and imprisonment for each and every offense.

In lieu of criminal action against any person, firm or corporation for any such violations, a fine or penalty in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation may be recovered by the County of Onondaga and in addition thereto any Permit issued pursuant to the provisions of such regulations may be suspended or revoked for violations of said provisions, or otherwise when deemed necessary for the protection of public health, all as provided in Section 6 of this Local Law.

Section 6. Civil Enforcement

In regard to all violations of this Local Law and penalties there under, the Onondaga County Commissioner of Water Environment Protection shall have authority to hold hearings, make findings of fact, determine whether violations of the Local Law have occurred, make orders and assess penalties in accordance with the following provisions:

1. The Commissioner shall cause a formal hearing to be held on any complaint, circumstances, or alleged violation of this Local Law prior to issuing any determination or order, fine or penalty.
2. Such formal hearing shall be on 10 days notice to the person or persons concerned, as the circumstances may require, and shall be set down for a day certain: a. The notice of the hearing shall set forth: (1) the time and place of the hearing; (2) the purpose of the hearing; (3) charges and violations complained of, if any, with specific reference to the provisions and sections of the involved; (4) the right to present evidence; (5) the right to examine and cross examine witnesses; (6) the right to be represented by counsel.
3. On the return day of the hearing, the commissioner or his authorized representative, including any member of the Examining Board for Plumbers, shall note the appearance of the persons attending the hearing. a. Witnesses shall be sworn and testimony shall be recorded b. The testimony shall be transcribed within a reasonable time after the conclusion of the hearing.

4. The commissioner, or his authorized representative, including any member of the Examining Board for Plumbers shall thereafter prepare findings of facts and conclusions, upon which the commissioner shall make a determination and decision, which shall be set forth in a formal order, setting forth the determination conditions, if any, to be complied with, and penalties, if any.
5. The order provided for in subdivision 4 of this section shall be filed in the department and a copy thereof shall be served on all persons concerned.
6. The penalty provided for may be sued and recovered by the Onondaga County Commissioner of Water Environment Protection in any Court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 7. Repealer

Upon enactment of this Local Law, Local Law No. 10 1982 is hereby repealed and superseded.

Section 8. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take place immediately upon proper filing pursuant to Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law

State, and 1 of whom shall be a member of the Onondaga County Legislature. Terms are 6 years for all members except legislator is a 2-year term.

Purpose: To advise the Commissioner of Health on matters regarding the preservation and improvement of public health and public services throughout the county.

County Library Board of Trustees

Members: 11 members appointed by the County Executive for 5-year terms with Legislature confirmation.

Purpose: The Library Board of Trustees has full control and supervision of the Public Library System. It employs the staff and makes the rules governing the Library.

Criminal Justice Advisory Board

Members: County Executive (or designee)

* City Court Judge

* Town or Village Justice

US Attorney, District Attorney, Sheriff

County Legislator, Commissioner of Probation

Commissioner of Correction and Chief Deputy,

Jail Division

Representative elected from local police agencies (one)

Syracuse Police Department

State Parole

Commissioner of Mental Health

Up to 2 representatives of agencies that provide legal services to those unable to afford counsel.

Representatives of private organizations with experience and involvement in alternatives to incarceration programs, as designated by the County Executive. Individual who provides state certified alcohol/substance abuse treatment services

Ex-offender and crime victim as designated by the County Executive

* As per appointment by Administrative Judge

Purpose: The Board shall develop and monitor a comprehensive plan for alternatives to incarceration programs; to review incarceration practices and trends through the use of jail population analysis; and to review jail overcrowding and develop solutions to alleviate the problem.

Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board

Members: 18 members appointed by the County Executive, representing the major components and respective agencies within the Emergency Medical Services System. Each member is appointed to a 3-year term.

Purpose: The Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board acts as an advisor to the County Legislature, County Executive, Commissioner of Health and the Director of Emergency Medical Services on all matters affecting public safety and emergency care.

Examining Board for Plumbers

Members: Up to 10 members appointed by the County Executive for a 3-year term, but not more than 2 consecutive terms as follows:

1 Representative from Master Plumbers Association

1 Representative from Journeymen in City of Syracuse

2 Representatives for Onondaga County Association of Plumbing Contractors

Chief Engineer of City of Syracuse (or designee)

Onondaga County Commissioner Water Environment Protection (or designee)

Onondaga County Commissioner of Health (or designee)

3 Residents of Onondaga County (non-voting)

Purpose: The Examining Board has jurisdiction and control over connections to public sewers; certifies plumbers who they deem qualified to perform plumbing work under the Department of Water Environment Protection in existing and future sanitary districts.

Fire Advisory Board

Members: Not less than 5 and no more than 21 members appointed by the County Executive with Legislature confirmation.

Members serve for a 3-year term, but not more than 2 consecutive terms.

Purpose: The Fire Advisory Board advises the County on all matters relating to fire training, fire service and mutual aid programs.

Forest Practice Board - District 3

Members: 3 members appointed by the County Executive, of whom 2 must be landowners or their representatives; 1 member serves as a representative of the Onondaga County Legislature; Legislative member serves 2-year terms; other members serve 3-year terms; with Legislative confirmation.

Purpose: The Regional Forest Practice Board shall determine the forest practice standards necessary for their regions and shall formally adopt such standards and promote their application.

Onondaga County/Syracuse Commission on Human Rights

Members: 24 members of whom 18 are appointed by the County Executive with Legislative confirmation; 6 shall be appointed upon recommendation of the Onondaga County Legislature and 6 are appointed by the Mayor. Members serve for a 3-year term.

Purpose: The Commission exists to foster the growth and development of City and County in the area of human relations, and to create a climate in which citizens of all races, creeds, and political beliefs can understand and respect each other.

Metropolitan Water Board

Members: 7 members of which not more than 5 shall be from the same political party. Chairman of Onondaga County Water Authority is a member; 3 must be City residents (with advice of Mayor) and 2 County residents living outside the City. The Legislature Chairman appoints the Chairperson. Members serve for a 3-year terms.

Purpose: The Board shall act as the administrative body of the Onondaga County Water District.

Onondaga Community College Board of Trustees

Members: 9 members, 5 appointed by the County Executive and 4 appointed by the Governor. Terms are for 9 years and the County Executive's appointments require Legislative confirmation.

Purpose: The major duties of the Board of Trustees are to elect a president or chief administrator of the institution; employ all personnel; purchase and acquire land necessary for the operation of the institution; receives and accepts private donations; and perform any other duties necessary.

LOCAL LAW NO. ___ - 2013

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PLUMBING FEES COLLECTED
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ONONDAGA COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF ONONDAGA, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Onondaga County Commissioner of Water Environment Protection is hereby empowered to collect plumbing fees for tests, permits, licenses and other services provided by the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection, as set forth herein.

Section 2. The plumbing fees to be charged as follows:

Section 3. The procedures for the collection of such fees shall be prescribed by the appropriate laws of the State, and any amendments thereto, or determined by the Commissioner of Water Environment Protection where the State has not enacted procedures.

Section 4. Local Law Nos. 9-1998, 4-1989, 11-1989, 16-2002, 25-2002, 8-2006, Resolution Nos. 16-1989, 382-1990, 299-1992 and any other prior resolution or Local Law establishing plumbing fees collected by Onondaga County hereby are amended to strike the plumbing fees provided for therein and to substitute the fees set forth in Section 2 of this Local Law.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect on January 1, 2014, or pursuant to the provisions of Municipal Home Rule Law.
