



Federal changes affecting Onpoint for 2010

Mental Health Parity Act – the plan will no longer impose a limit on mental health benefits that are less than that applied to the medical and surgical benefits.

“Michelle’s Law” – Seriously ill or injured full-time college students are covered up to one year, if their physician provides written documentation supporting the need for medical leave. To be eligible, a student must already have been covered by the parent’s health insurance plan.
