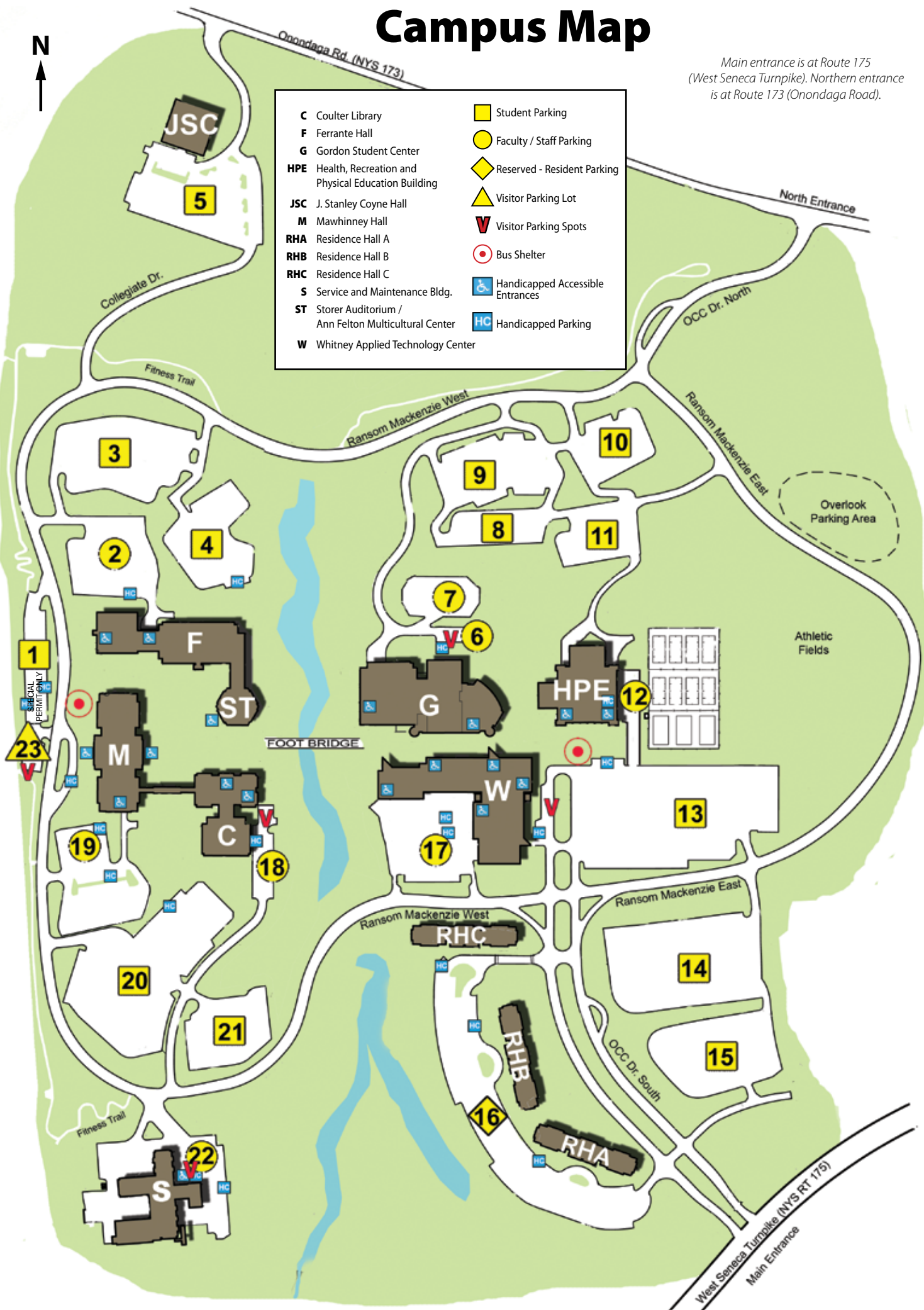


Campus Map

Mawhinney Hall (M)

President's Suite; Reading, Writing, Mathematics and Study Skills Laboratories; offices and classrooms for Professional Communication, Criminal Justice, English, General Studies, Human Services and Teacher Education; Mathematics, Modern Languages and Social Sciences departments.

Coulter Library Building (C)

Academic Computing Center, College Library, Content Tutoring Center, Health Services; offices for Alumni Affairs, Human Resources, Institutional Advancement, Institutional Research and Planning, Public Affairs.

J. Stanley Coyne Hall (JSC)

Public Safety Training Center, Central New York Police Academy, and College for Living; classrooms for Homeland Security and Law Enforcement.

Ferrante Hall (F)

Storer Auditorium, Ann Felton Multicultural Center and Gallery, International Student Services; classrooms, laboratories and offices for the Sciences and Health Professions departments; office, classrooms and studios for Art and Graphic Arts.

Gordon Student Center (G)

Student Central (Admissions, Advisement and Testing, Counseling and Career Services, Financial Aid, Registrar), Bookstore, Bursar, Cafeteria, Disability Services Office, Student Services, Student Support Programs (EOP, CSTEP, Veterans' Affairs), The "Great Room," Student Association, classrooms and offices for the Music and Hospitality Management departments.

Health, Physical Education and Recreation Building (H)

Intercollegiate athletics, gymnasium, swimming pool, fitness center; classrooms and offices for Physical Education and Recreation Leadership department, and the Children's Learning Center.

Service and Maintenance Building (S)

Central Receiving and Campus Facilities, Campus Safety and Security; offices for Financial and Management Services, Information Technology.

Whitney Applied Technology Center (W)

Student and Academic Services administrative offices; classrooms for Architecture, Automotive Technology, Business Administration, Computer Studies, Electrical Engineering Technology, Electronic Media Communications, Mechanical Technology, Photography, Corporate and Extended Learning, Lifelong Learning, Clean Communities of CNY, Small Business Development Center (SBDC).
