

New York State Vaccine Program

Annual Educational Requirement

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the New York State (NYS) Vaccine Program requires the Vaccine Coordinator and the Back-up Vaccine Coordinator at each provider office to participate in a yearly training. To satisfy this requirement, all providers must view the “You Call the Shots” Vaccines for Children overview (<http://www2a.cdc.gov/nip/isd/ycts/mod1/courses/vfc/ce.asp>) and at least one vaccine storage and handling webinar by December 31, 2015.

The NYS Vaccine Program has identified three options to satisfy the vaccine storage and handling requirement. Please choose at least one of the following trainings to satisfy the storage and handling requirement:
