Adult caregivers are always an integral part of our treatment strategies. Sliding scale fee for families who do not have health insurance.

Family Support Services (FSS)

Provides short term support to adult caregivers who are parenting children or youth who face significant mental health challenges. FSS works with families to assess needs, advocate for services, assist in accessing community resources, and support adult caregivers both to achieve parenting goals and to support their children and youth in achieving personal goals. There is **no charge** for these services and all services are customized to meet the family's unique needs.

Day Treatment Program

Provides intensive mental health treatment for children and adolescents between the ages of 5 and 18 years old who reside in Onondaga County. The program provides comprehensive services to address the emotional, behavioral, psychological, social, medical and academic needs of children and adolescents who are experiencing significant difficulty functioning at school, home and community.

The program operates year round. Family participation and collaboration are an integral part of the Day Treatment Program.

Children and adolescents are referred to Day Treatment by their home school district. Families interested in Day Treatment should discuss this with their district Committee on Special Education.
