### Deputies Investigating Serious Crash

**Town of Cicero, New York** – Onondaga County Sheriff Kevin E. Walsh reports that deputies are currently investigating a serious one car crash on Route 81.

At approximately 5:41 pm, sheriff's deputies responded to a rollover crash on Route 81 south, just south of Route 31, where a 1999 Chevrolet Blazer went off the road and rolled several times. Witnesses said that the vehicle was seen traveling south on Route 81 and was traveling at a high rate of speed, weaving in and out of traffic, when the driver lost control of the SUV. The Blazer went off the west shoulder of the road, rolled several times, came to rest on it's wheels and caught fire. Passing motorist stopped to assist and managed to pull the driver from the vehicle.

The driver, who has not been identified, was transported to University Hospital with multiple injuries believed to be life threatening. No other vehicles were involved in the crash and members of the Sheriff's Accident Investigation Team will conduct a complete investigation.

Sheriff's deputies, with assistance from the New York State Police and New York State Department of Transportation have restricted traffic to one southbound lane near the crash until the scene can be cleared.
