### Evening Brings End to Second Day of Ground Search

**Town of Clay, New York** – Onondaga County Sheriff Kevin E. Walsh reports that the second day of ground search has come to an end.

Today, search and rescue crews from the Wilderness **Search and Rescue**, **Oswego County Search and Rescue**, **Cayuga County Search and Resuce**, **Massasauga Search and Rescue**, along with **Eagle Valley Search Dogs** continued searching a wooded area between Henry Clay Boulevard, Morgan Road, Buckley Road and Route 481. Crews covered nearly 600 acres over the past two days searching for Jenni-Lyn or any clues that will help locate her.

Detectives investigating Jenni-Lyn's disappearance established the heavily wooded area to be a point of interest based on her cellular phone activity records.

In addition to the search, detectives continued to follow a variety of leads including information regarding a dark colored pickup truck that may have been in the area of Donegal Way the day Jenni-Lyn was reported missing. Detectives are asking anyone who may have been in the area between 7:00am and 3:00pm who may have been operating or seen the pickup to contact the Sheriff's Office. Detectives are hopeful the driver may have information that could further the investigation.

Yesterday Sheriff's Detectives traveled to Mercyhurst College, where they have met with faculty and staff to obtain addition information regarding Jenni-Lyn that also may help their efforts.

The Sheriff's Office has received an extremely high volume of calls with information and is following up on leads as they are developed and will continue to do so throughout the Thanksgiving holiday weekend.

Anyone with information regarding Jenni-Lyn's whereabouts is asked to call **435-3081**. People interested in volunteering to help search for Jenni-Lyn are asked **NOT** to call this line.

The Sheriff's Office will be asking for volunteers to search in the near future and will be provided a telephone number to call once plans are finalized and services are needed.

Jenni-Lyn Watson (20), of 7406 Donegal Way, was reported missing by family members on Friday, November 19<sup>th</sup>. Family members told deputies that Watson was last seen Friday morning and that it was uncharacteristic of her to leave without notice or maintain communication with them.

Jenni-Lyn is a white female who is 5' 2" and weighs approximately 100 pound. She has dirty blonde hair and brown eyes. Watson is known to carry a Verizon LG enV3 cellular phone with a blue cover.
