MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Promotion

One (1) year of permanent competitive class status in the title of Sanitary Engineer

Open Competitive:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a baccalaureate degree in chemical, civil, sanitary or environmental engineering and two (2) years of professional level engineering work experience, or its part-time equivalent related to wastewater treatment or water pollution control; or
- B. Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a baccalaureate degree in chemistry, biology, physics, environmental science or environmental studies and three (3) years of technical or professional level engineering work experience or its part-time equivalent related to wastewater treatment or water pollution control, two (2) years of which must have been in a professional level capacity in engineering related to wastewater treatment or water pollution control; or,
- C. An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B)

- NOTE: Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a master's degree in engineering and/or science may be substituted for work experience as follows:
- Thirty (30) semester credit hours equals one (1) year of work experience.
Sixty (60) semester credit hours equals two (2) years of work experience.
