DO I NEED A PLUMBING PERMIT? QUICK GUIDE



I NEED TO REPLACE MY LEAKY FAUCET

The repair or replacement of a faucet, flush valve, supply tube, individual fixture stops, toilet fill valves, or flushing mechanisms that are in-kind to what you currently have do not require a plumbing permit.



I AM FINISHING MY BASEMENT AND ADDING A BATHROOM

A plumbing permit is required before the installation of new plumbing systems, even if the homeowner is doing the work themselves.



MY HOT WATER HEATER NEEDS REPLACING

A plumbing permit is required prior to the installation of a new water heater. Homeowners should also keep in mind that this household essential can be dangerous if installed incorrectly. Any small error in the installation of a gas water heater could cause a poisonous gas leak or explosion.



HELP! I HAVE A PLUMBING EMERGENCY!

Plumbing permits must be obtained prior to any work EXCEPT in an emergency. However, a permit must be obtained the first business day following the emergency and work cannot be covered, backfilled, or concealed before an inspection is done by WEP's Plumbing Control Division.

Any commercial, industrial, institutional, or multiple-family house needs plumbing plan approval and permits issued by WEP's Plumbing Control Division prior to work starting.
